- Board members find that the following CVC Policy does apply to this claim:
 - **SECTION 19.0 Contributory Conduct**
 - 19.1 Victim's Wrongful Conduct**
 - A. The CVC Board will review claims for compensation to determine if the victim's wrongful act or provocation contributed to the injuries suffered by the victim. When the CVC Board determines that a victim's injuries were substantially attributable to the victim's wrongful act or provocation, the CVC Board may deny or reduce the award.
 - B. The maximum amount payable when the CVC Board determines that there has been contributory wrongful conduct on the part of the victim is \$5,000.
 - Board approves up to policy maximum of \$5,000.00 per above CVC policy.
